A Note from the Board of Directors

Our Annual Meeting on July 1st followed by the picnic and fireworks were a tremendous success. As always, it was good to see our Members participate in these events. We would like to thank all the volunteers who put in hours and days making this a wonderful experience. At our annual meeting the Members voted for a Special Assessment in the amount of \$30,000 in order to demolish the structure at 579 Tobacco Branch Road. The deadline for paying the Special Assessment was September 30, 2023. If you have not paid, please pay now before additional interest is assessed. We are in the process of scheduling the demolition and will keep everybody apprised of the schedule.

If you have not registered on the website please do so. You can conveniently pay the Special Assessment or Annual Assessments online. It is also helpful to follow the board meetings and activities. We will be scheduling our next quarterly meeting in October so monitor the website for the agenda and minutes.

Water Updates

From the Board: We have been obtaining water quality tests of the lake from June through October for the last two (2) years with plans to continue testing into the foreseeable future. While the water quality fluctuates due to heat and rainfall, we continue to have excellent water quality test results. Should anything differ, we will immediately advise the membership. The test results are posted on the website.
